gion. The Centennial Shepherd Staff travelled in the different regions in the country from July 31, 2011 starting with St. Bridget College Batangas followed by NCR, Cebu, Baguio, Cavite, Bicol, Mindanao and Isabela.

On August 19, procession began at the Good Shepherd gate with the people stopping at the eight stations where the banners of photos of each Regional Celebration stand. Sisters, mission partners and Fr. Antonio de Castro SJ, presider of the Mass, carried the banners to the chapel.

During his homily, Fr. de Castro expressed gratitude that he has been part of the celebration and that the introduction before the Mass that recounted the arrival of the Good Shepherd Sisters, the foundation of communities in the Philippines that answered the needs of women and children needing compassion and the challenges encountered, summarized the journey of the Good

Shepherd in the Philippines during the past 100 years. In 2009, he said, "the three years preparation of the centennial must be an occasion for the sisters to tell stories, of one another of those people served in the ministry and then draw lessons from them." He found the theme, "Weaving Compassion, Embracing Challenges, Forging Hope" very apt for the celebration.

The prayers of the faithful were read in the different Filipino languages — Bicolano, Pampango, Pangasinense, Ilongo, Cebuano, Ilocano, Ibanag, Cordillera-Kalinga, and Tagalog.

After the Thanksgiving Mass, program and lunch followed.

The Holy Cross Band 5th edition of Santolan, Pasig City played the "Sandaang Taon" hymn and Yakap ng Pastol, among other Filipino songs.

Families also visited **Museum Idyll** which highlighted the different communities in the country.
